

# **NHS SELECTION PROCEDURE**

## **STEP ONE**

**A student should have an average of 85% from grade 9 at the school OR if the student is new, the student's average for the first two quarters must be 85% and above - to continue to go through the rest of the selection process.**

## **STEP TWO**

**If the student has satisfied the first step, then the student should not have any demerits against his/her name. Demerits will cause one to be excluded from the rest of the selection process.**

## **STEP THREE**

**The student will have to complete a Student Information Form, listing dates, events and activities. Each activity must be verified by an adult sponsor. Services must be authenticated by service sheets and signed by adult sponsors. Any other documentation such as verified copies of certificates and awards must also be attached to the form.**

## **STEP FOUR**

**The faculty committee, made up of five teachers will review the information on the Student Information form and students will be selected to become a member of the ISG-Dammam National Honor Society. The NHS Adviser does not vote students in - this is done by the five-teacher committee.**

## **STEP FIVE**

**If you have been successfully selected, you will be notified in person by the NHS Adviser.**
